



#### March Safety Challenge

#### March is National Ladder Safety Month! 🏗 🔺

Did you know that falls are the leading cause of death in the construction industry and one of OSHA's Focus Four hazards? Stay safe by following these ladder safety tips:

- ✓ Read all labels before using the ladder.
- ✓ Maintain three points of contact when climbing up or down.
- ✓ Avoid using the top step/rung unless specifically designed for it.
- ✓ Ensure extension ladder locks are fully engaged.
- ✓ Never exceed the maximum load capacity.
- ✓ Set the ladder on a stable, level surface before use.
- ✓ Inspect the ladder for damage before each use.
- ✓ Consider a "Ladders Last" policy—evaluate other safer options (e.g., extended-reach tools, scaffolding, MEWPs) before using a ladder.
